

Dr. Don on COVID-19 COVID Vaccine Value Becomes Obvious

I was originally going to write about the Current COVID situation in Florida and Texas and the danger posed by vaccine avoidance when I saw the following headline: CDC: More than 99.99% of fully vaccinated people have not had a severe breakthrough case of Covid-19. The facts behind the current "pandemic of the unvaccinated" have become increasingly obvious.

Anyone who has studied immunity resulting from vaccination have learned that vaccines routinely fail to provide protection to a percentage of those vaccinated. The vaccine failure rate varies widely from 30 to 40+% with influenza vaccines, 7% for chickenpox, 3% for measles and to less than one percent for individuals given 3 to 4 oral polio vaccines. The oral polio vaccine was found to on rare occasions cause polio and was eliminated from common use. Also, immunity fades, sometimes in weeks, often in months. I can only think of one vaccine considered to provide decades long immunity, the vaccine against the yellow fever virus carried in tropical mosquitoes.

Although rare complications do occur, vaccinations are considered to have prevented more serious illness and death than any other medical breakthrough. We see this again today. More than 99.99% of people who are fully vaccinated against Covid-19 have not had a breakthrough case resulting in hospitalization or death, according to a CNN analysis of data from the US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).

As of Aug. 2, more than 164 million people in the United States were fully vaccinated against Covid-19, according to the CDC. Fewer than 0.001% of those individuals — 1,507 people — died and fewer than 0.005% — 7,101 people — were hospitalized with Covid-19.

About three-quarters (74%) of all reported breakthrough cases were among seniors age 65 or older. Of the roughly 1,500 people who died, one in five passed away from something other than Covid-19 even though they had a breakthrough case of the virus, according to the CDC.

Since May, the CDC has focused on investigating only hospitalized or fatal cases among those who have been fully vaccinated.

According to the CDC, this data "help[s] identify patterns and look[s] for signals among vaccine breakthrough cases." According to the CDC "To date, no unexpected patterns have been identified in the case demographics or vaccine characteristics among people with reported vaccine breakthrough infections." Full COVID vaccination is working.
